How to volunteer at FMC

Recipients of the FMC Scholarship are asked to volunteer at FMC, for 15-20 hours, these hours will primarily be accumulated during the summer, but can be started any time prior to that. Information regarding FMC Scholarship

How it works:

- There are 2 ways this scholarship benefits you:
 - First, depending on how many years you have attended Youth Group during high school you are eligible for up to \$1000 a year from FMC.
 - 1 yr in Youth Group - \$250
 - 2 yr in Youth Group - \$500
 - 3 yr. in Youth Group - \$750
 - 4 yr. in Youth Group - \$1000
 - Second, most Christian schools have what is called a "Church Matching" scholarship. What this means is that your school will in most cases match dollar for dollar what your church donates.
 - It is your responsibility to obtain your schools "Church Matching" paperwork and turn it in to Pastor Jake
 - We ask that you get these forms from your school and return them by March 1st or at least 3 weeks before the deadline.
- There are 3 things you need to complete in order to receive the FMC scholarship:
 - (By March 1st or 3 weeks prior to your schools' deadline) Turn in your "**Church Matching**" form to Jake Shipe in the church office
 - It is the responsibility of the student to obtain a copy of their school's "Church Matching" scholarship form and give this to Pastor Jake.
 - Students can send the form as an attachment and Pastor Jake will print it off and submit it
 - Students can print off the form and put it in Pastor Jake's church mailbox which is located inside the church office. Please DO NOT put this in his public mailbox in the hallway.
 - (By the end of May) Complete and submit the **digital FMC application** to Pastor Jake
 - If you are a new scholarship recipient email Pastor Jake and ask him to send you the link for the digital application
 - If you are a current recipient you will receive an email for a new application to be filled out.
 - Students need to complete and submit a digital application every year they wish to receive the scholarship up to four years.
 - (Before you head to school in the fall of spring) Complete **15-20 hours of voluntary service**, details are on attached page
- What happens if items are not completed on time?
 - If the "Church Matching" form is not received by the school's deadline, money cannot be guaranteed.
 - If the digital application is not submitted to Pastor Jake by the end of June, students will not receive money for the year they are applying.
 - Students need to submit the digital tracking form for volunteer hours by the last week of July because Aug. 1st is the deadline for FMC to send scholarship money to the various schools.
 - It is likely a student may not have completed all their hours before they submit the form. By submitting the form students are indicating that they will complete all the hours before they leave for school.
 - If students are unable to complete all their hours before they submit the form, they will need to email Pastor Jake letting him know when the hours are complete: jake@fairviewangola.com
