Small Group Questions

3. What can you give up to make this giving more meaningful to you?

5. What is your motivation to give?
6. What practical strategies do you use and try to develop in changing or preparing your heart to follow Jesus in a more complete way?
7. How do you discuss with your children examples of loving your neighbor in any way(s), but particularly with regards to giving money to your church for missions?
8. Are tithes and offerings the same or different?
9. As you tithe is the word sacrifice ever considered as you decide what to give?
