- Change the altars/rails.

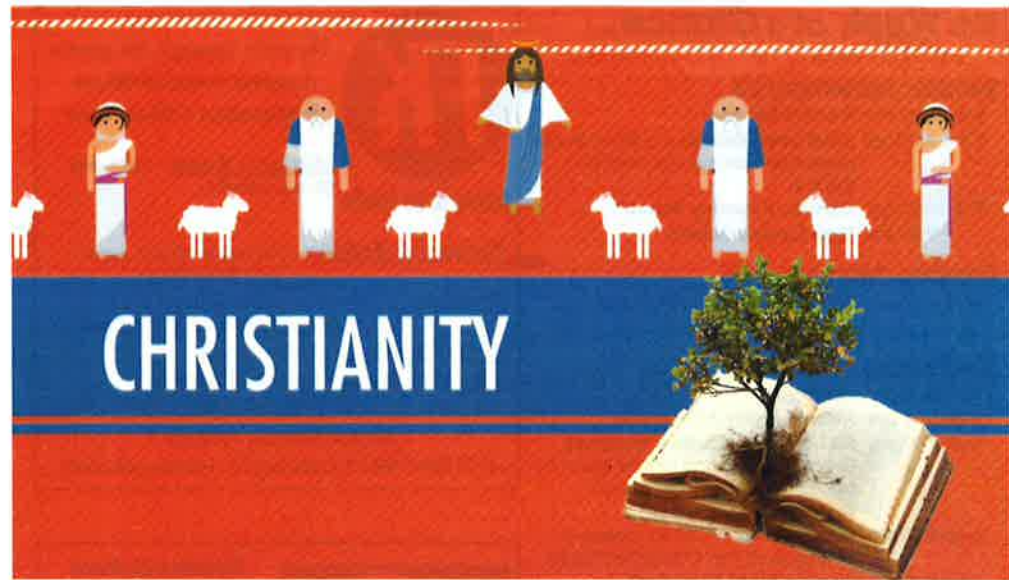
- Restain the pews.

We have replaced all our 24 hour light fixtures in the building with LED high efficiency light fixtures with the help of a rebate from REMC. A 24 hour light pays for itself in energy savings in just nine months. We are now slowly replacing the dusk to dawn light fixtures with LEDs. An interesting note about the dusk to dawn lights inside the globes on the north side of the church between the sidewalk and church, we have only replaced one of those lightbulbs in 18 years. We may never replace those fixtures.
